Basic Stitches Used

- Half double crochet (hdc)

Oven Mitt Pattern

Skill Level: Beginner

Gauge: 4" x 4" = 16 sc x 16 rows

Measurements: Approximately 9" x 7"

Instructions:

Foundation Chain:

* Chain 20.

Row 1:

* Sc in the 2nd chain from the hook and in each chain across. (19 sc)

Row 2-18:

* Ch 1, turn. Sc in each sc across. (19 sc)

Top Edging:

* Ch 2, turn. Hdc around the top edge, working 2 hdc in each corner. Join with a sl st to the first hdc.

Thumb Hole:

* Leave a space of 3 sc on the side of the mitt. * To create the thumb hole, ch 15. * Fold the chain in half and sc around the opening, working 2 sc in each corner. Join with a sl st to the first sc.

Finishing:

* Weave in loose ends. * Fold the mitt in half and sew the sides together.

Potholder Pattern

Skill Level: Beginner

Gauge: 4" x 4" = 16 sc x 16 rows

Measurements: Approximately 8" x 8"

Instructions:

Foundation Chain:

* Chain 20.

Row 1:

* Sc in the 2nd chain from the hook and in each chain across. (19 sc)

Row 2-20:

* Ch 1, turn. Sc in each sc across. (19 sc)

Top Loop:

* Ch 15. * Fold the chain in half and sc around the opening, working 2 sc in each corner. Join with a sl st to the first sc.

Finishing:

* Weave in loose ends. * Fold the potholder in half and sew the sides together.

Tips for Crocheting Your Oven Mitt and Potholder Set

* Use a stitch marker to keep track of the beginning of the round. * Hold the yarn taut to create a firm and durable fabric. * If your mitt or potholder is turning out too loose or too tight, adjust the tension of your stitches. * Be patient and take your time, especially when working on the intricate details. * Don't be afraid to make mistakes. It's all part of the learning process.
